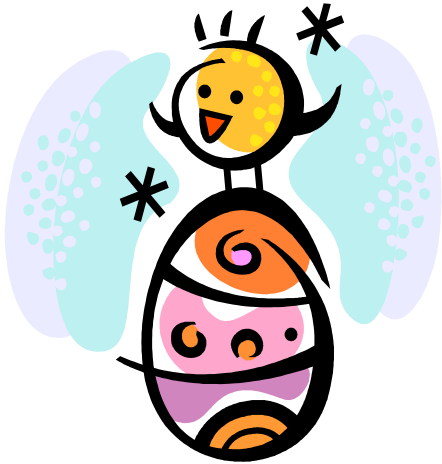

EASTER MONDAY DINNER

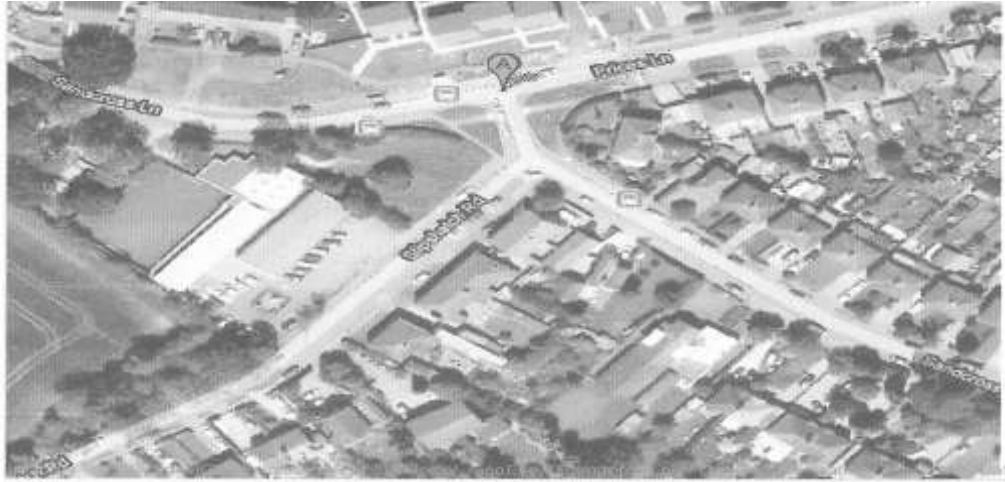

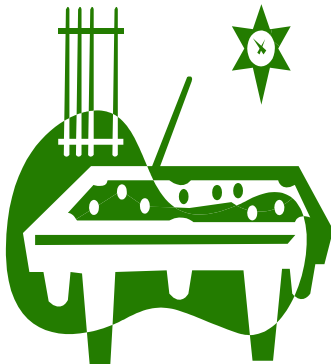

POOL TOURNAMENT



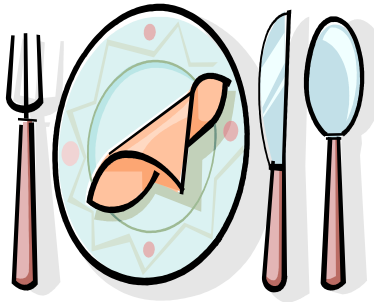
